5) In species removal unit 2, cut all red maple, sugar maple, and ironwood with one or more sticks. Don't cut aspen.

6) In unit 3 cut all aspen, sugar maple, red maple, and ironwood with one or more sticks.

7) In units 1 and 2, cut all white birch > 10 inches DBH.

8) Cutting will be allowed from July 15th to April 1 under dry, frozen or deep snow conditions.

SALE OBJECTIVES: The harvest objective is to remove poor quality red and sugar maple and mature fir and to either release red oak pole trees or regenerate the stands to a mixture of aspen, fir and maple. About 7 acres of second-thinning red pine plantation was marked as well as a 2 -acre spruce plantation will be clearcut. Maple sawlogs will have small hearts but are limby so log grades will mostly be grade 2 and grade 3 with minor amounts of grade 1 and veneer.


Access & Terrain- Direct woods road access from Black Joe road from the north. The south side of the sale may be accessed from N. Rollingstone Lake Rd. An extensive woods road network ensures short skidding distances. Terrain is flat or rolling hills with some rocky areas and wet pockets. Soils are sandy loam and silt loam in drainages. Roads and soils are mostly well-drained and will drain quickly following rain.

OTHER SALE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS:

- The BCPL can restrict the type of equipment used on the job if conditions or damage warrant.
- BMP's (see Field Manual PUB-FR-093-2010) are mandatory for this sale.


