- 1) Cut all red maple, sugar maple, ironwood, aspen and white birch with one or more sticks.
- 2) Do not cut any oaks, elms, basswood, white pine or yellow birch.
- 3) Do not cut trees marked in teal paint.
- 4) Cutting lines are marked with blue property boundaries or red cutting lines.
- 5) Logging from July 15th to April 1.

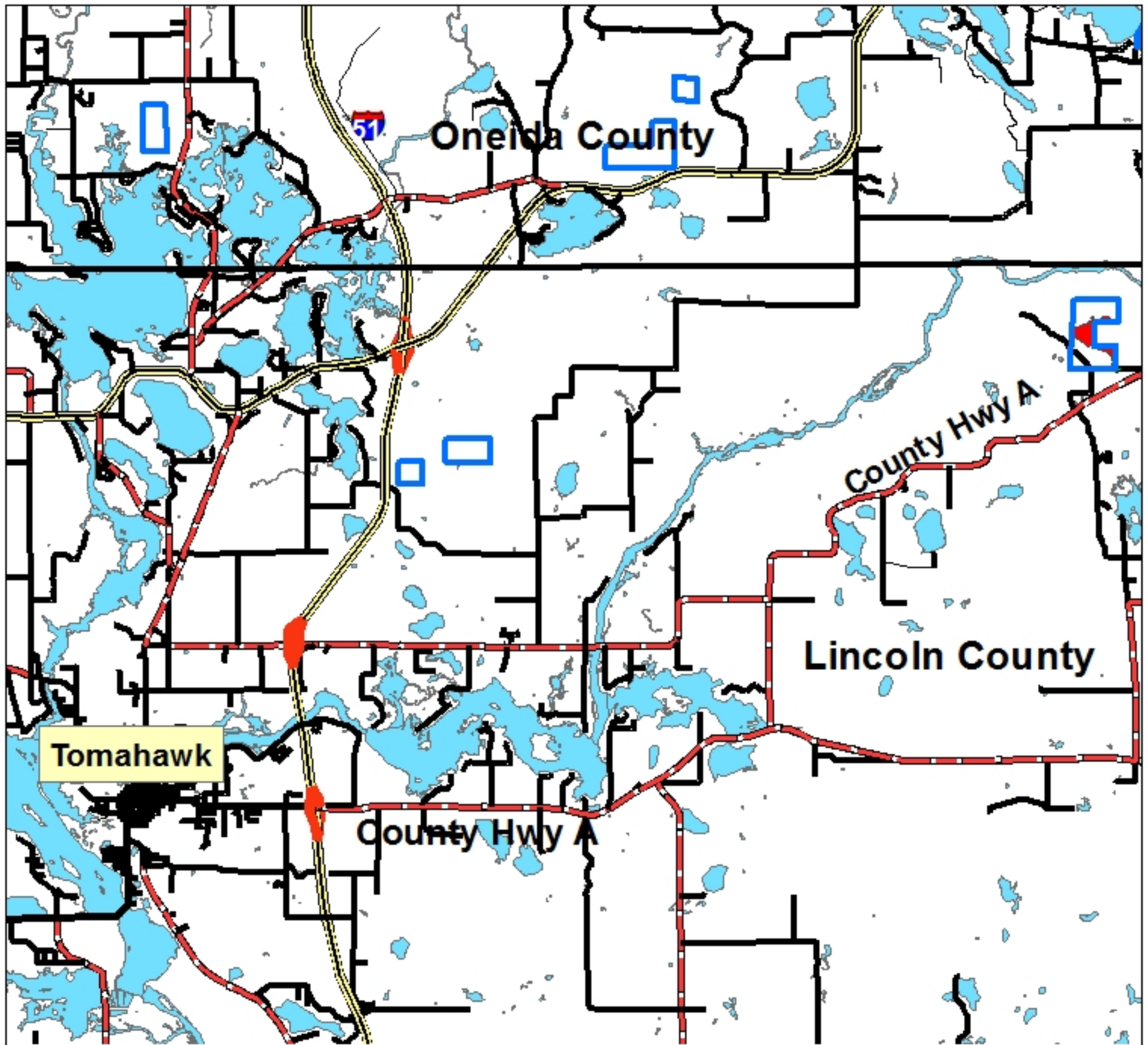
SALE OBJECTIVES: The harvest objective is to regenerate aspen and to maintain the red oak component to grow into higher quality logs and bolts.

Access & Terrain- Site can be reached by coming up from County Hwy A and taking Old Hwy A to sandy stub roads. The site is hilly and most skids are short but some of the wood will need skids up to ¼ mile.

OTHER SALE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS:

- The BCPL can restrict the type of equipment used on the job if conditions or damage warrant.
- BMP's (see Field Manual PUB-FR-093-2010) are mandatory for this sale.
- Notify the BCPL (715-277-3366) before you start the job.
- Site is close to major aspen purchasers such as PCA & LP (15 miles): A single truck may be able to deliver 50-60 cords per day to these local mills based upon travel times.
- Mixed hardwoods will have a ton to cord conversion rate of 2.3

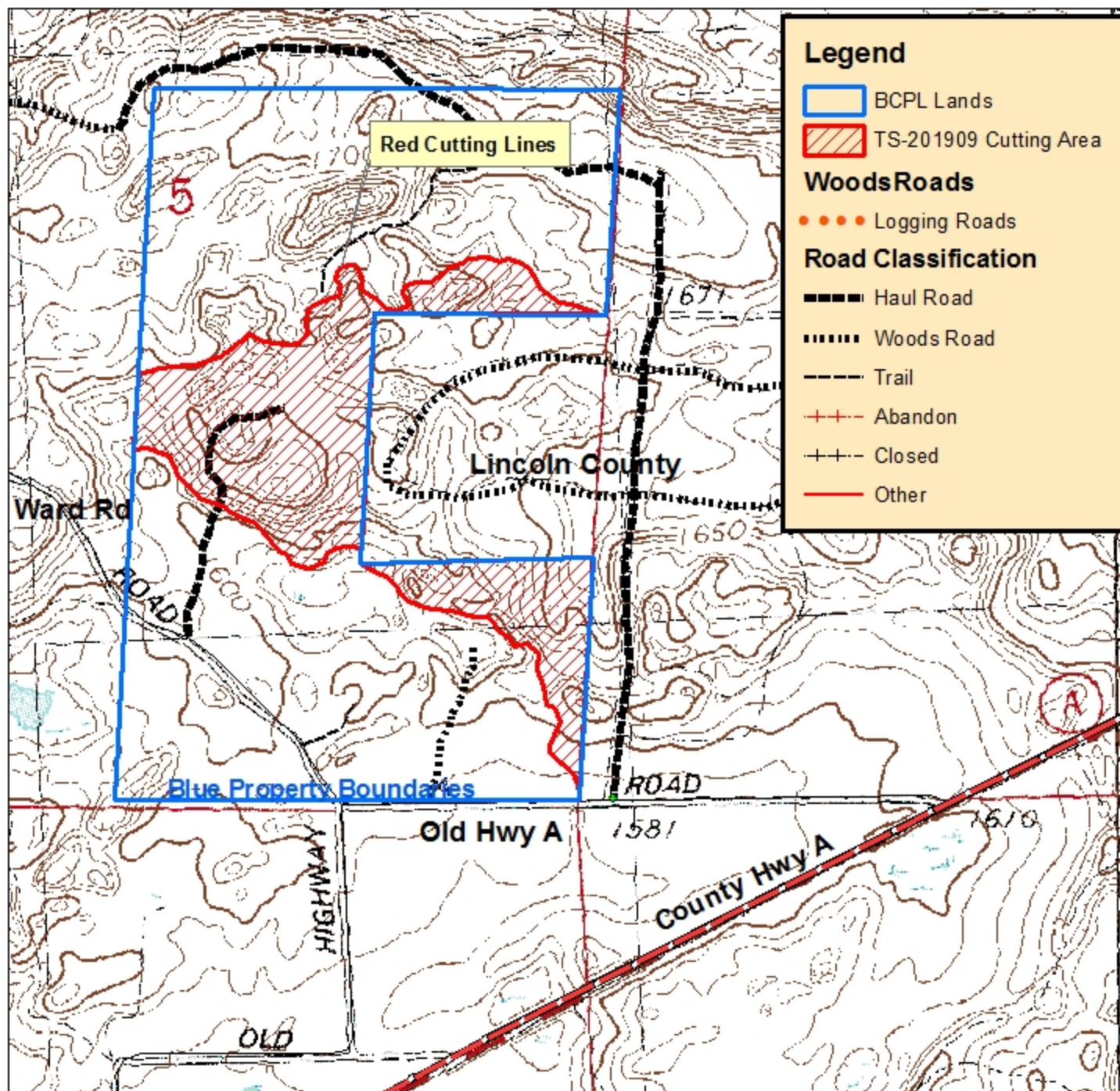
