2) Cut all white birch > 8 inches DBH

3) Do not cut any pines, spruce, tamarack or other hardwoods.

4) Do not cut any trees with blue, red or teal paint.

5) Cutting is allowed any time the roads are dry enough for hauling. This is a break-up job.




