CUTTING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Pine Thinning Units Cut all trees marked with green paint. Cut all aspen, spruce, fir and jack pine less than 18" DBH.
- 2. Aspen Clearcut Units- Cut trees of all species less than 18" DBH except for those with red, blue, or purple paint.
- 3. Pine Clearcut Unit- Cut trees of all species except for those with red or blue paint.
- 4. Cutting boundaries are set by roads, blue property lines, red cutting lines or purple shared unit boundary lines. See timber sale map for unit boundaries and prescriptions.
- 5. Cutting will be allowed year-round.

SALE OBJECTIVES: Second red pine thinning to reduce stocking by removing trees with poor form and vigor. Regenerate mature aspen pockets. Rotate two acre red pine stand that has reached maturity and convert to aspen. Lack of previous management has produced trees with less than 15% live crown and averages 260 BA. Poor access and lack of adjacent land to plant pine make the stand an outlier from the rest of the property and doesn't justify replanting.

ACCESS & TERRAIN: Good access from paved Pine Lake Rd. Easement access from the north end of the property or road use agreement with private landowner to use gated road on NE 40. Terrain is flat and excellent drainage allows for year-round cutting and hauling.

OTHER SALE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS:

- The BCPL can restrict the type of equipment used on the job if conditions or damage warrant.
- Logging operations may be suspended if excessive rutting is occurring.
- BMP's (see Field Manual PUB-FR-093-2010) are mandatory for this sale.
- Notify the BCPL (715-277-3366) before you start the job.
- A soil berm at the entrance to the easement road will need to be removed for cutting and replaced after timber sale completion if logger chooses to use this route.
- A short stub road and landing (approximately 100') will need to be constructed to access the 2.25 acre pine clearcut unit.
