ITEM 4. APPROVE PUBLIC RECORDS POLICY

Board Chair La Follette asked if a motion was necessary. Deputy Secretary German replied that a motion would be preferred given that this was an official Board policy. During the course of a year, the office hours of the District Office will change depending on the field activities of office staff and it is reasonable to grant the Executive Secretary the authority and flexibility to change the record inspection times in accordance with changing seasonal office hours without requiring additional Board approval.

ITEM 5. CITY OF LACROSSE LOAN LIMIT EXCEPTION

Board Chair La Follette explained that the city was asking to exceed the \$5 million loan limit by \$1.5 million for an economic development project. Deputy Secretary German explained that once the Board approves the exception, the loan analyst would send the city an application.
