MOTION: Commissioner Sass moved to approve the loans; Board Chair La Follette seconded the motion. The motion passed, 2-0.

ITEM 4. PROPOSED WAUSAU PAPER LAND BANK ACQUISITIONS

Board Chair La Follette explained that staff had negotiated with Wausau Papers to purchase certain lands that were adjacent to Trust Lands and a smaller, 204 acre parcel that was not adjacent to other Trust Lands. He observed that the price was reasonable and that the lands contained productive timber. Executive Secretary noted that the closings on property sold to the DNR would be complete within the week, which would provide funding for these purchases. The desired closing date for the Wausau Papers property would be the end of September 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands authorizes the purchase of the Property at the price of Two Million, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand, Five Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars (\$2,250,596.00) in accordance with Chapter 24 of the Wisconsin Statutes on such terms and conditions as the Executive Secretary determines to be reasonable and necessary. The Executive Secretary is authorized and directed to execute any documents reasonably necessary to complete such purchase transaction

MOTION: Commissioner Sass moved that the Board approve the purchase of the property; Board Chair La Follette seconded the motion. The motion passed, 2-0.

ITEM 5. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

Executive Secretary Nelson forwarded a memo prepared by Deputy Secretary German to the Commissioners which explained the federal and state land patent process. Commissioner Van Hollen had questions on the process and the memo addressed them. She said that she would be bringing the state land patent to their offices for their signatures.

She noted that Deputy Secretary German clarified that funds would be available to close the Wausau Paper transactions once the DNR sale was complete but not enough to purchase the access property to those lands.

ITEM 6. ADJOURN

MOTION: Commissioner Sass moved to adjourn the meeting; Board Chair La Follette seconded the motion. The motion passed, 2-0.
