ITEM 4. PROPOSED LAND BANK SALE TO VILAS COUNTY (S1409)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands approves the sale of the Old 45 Road Property to Vilas County at the price of Ninety-five Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$95,100) in accordance with Chapter 24 of the Wisconsin Statutes on such terms and conditions as the Executive Secretary determines to be reasonable and necessary. The Executive Secretary is authorized and directed to execute any documents reasonably necessary to complete such transaction.

ITEM 5. PROPOSED SUBMERGED LANDS LEASE - CITY OF ASHLAND

Board Chair La Follette explained that the city of Ashland will be converting an abandoned oredock over Lake Superior into a public walkway for fishing and other recreational activities.

MOTION: Commissioner Schuller moved to approve the submerged lands lease; Commissioner Van Hollen seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands authorizes a fifty-year Submerged Lands Lease with the City of Ashland in accordance with Section 24.39 of the Wisconsin Statutes with a rental rate of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per year for the purposes of improving navigation, improving or constructing "harbor facilities" or for improvement or provision of recreational facilities related to navigation for public use, on such other terms and conditions as the Executive Secretary determines to be reasonable and necessary. The Executive Secretary is authorized and directed to execute any documents reasonably necessary to complete such transaction.

AGENDA ITEM 4 LOAN LIMIT EXCEPTION – CITY OF OSHKOSH

Description of Request

The city of Oshkosh has requested an exception to the annual loan limit, which is currently set at \$10 million for total loans to any customer within a calendar year. Oshkosh is requesting the exception to apply for two loans totaling \$11.85 million, including a \$10.4 million loan to refinance WRS pension liabilities and \$1.45 million to fund three economic development projects.

Available Funds Analysis

The BCPL currently has approximately \$107 million in unencumbered funds. BCPL staff feels that adequate funds are available to honor this request without impairing the ability of other communities to utilize the BCPL State Trust Fund Loan Program.

In addition, BCPL-managed cash is invested in the State Investment Fund (SIF) that currently pays 0.09% on an annualized basis. As the rate of return earned on these loans would be much higher, we believe the request provides a prudent opportunity for the BCPL to improve the overall return earned on invested funds.

BCPL Staff Recommendation

Based on the above information, BCPL staff recommends that the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands grant the request from the city of Oshkosh for an exception to the loan limit in an amount sufficient to allow the city of Oshkosh to apply for loans totaling up to \$11.85 million in 2014.
