ITEM 4. PROPOSED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH WI DEPARTMENT OF **REVENUE**

Deputy Secretary German said DOR had developed a new methodology for determining the amount of unclaimed property to be transferred to the Common School Fund from the DOR, and BCPL had provided some input to DOR on that matter. The purpose of this MOU was to facilitate the exchange of information between the agencies, provide a continuing means for BCPL to provide input to DOR on the methodology, and provide a framework for addressing any concerns that may arise.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands authorizes and directs the Executive Secretary to execute an MOU with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and take whatever actions are reasonably necessary to implement the MOU.
