MOTION: Board Chair Schimel moved to approve the loans; Commissioner La Follette seconded the motion.

DISCUSSION: Commissioner Adamczyk expressed additional concern regarding energy efficiency loans to school districts that are not approved in a referendum, even though the law allows this.

VOTE: The motion passed 2-1. Commissioner La Follette and Board Chair Schimel voted aye; Commissioner Adamczyk voted no.

[At this point in the meeting Board Chair Schimel allowed Executive Secretary Barry to provide the Board with an update on the Wisconsin Center District negotiations, as part of his Executive Secretary Report.]

ITEM 8. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY REPORT

Executive Secretary Barry reported that negotiations regarding the Milwaukee Bucks Arena had been finalized with the Wisconsin Center District, the Department of Administration, and bond counsel. The BCPL's investment in the project will be \$35 million.

ITEM 4. DISCUSS HAVING AN IN-PERSON BOARD MEETING (CLOSED OR OPEN) REGARDING INVESTMENT STRATEGIES BEFORE STAFF GIVES RECOMMENDATIONS

The Commissioners and Executive Secretary Barry discussed scheduling an in-person board meeting the first week of July to examine investment strategies and whether a portion of the meeting would need to be held in closed session. Executive Secretary Barry said that staff would research the closed session requirement and make a recommendation to the Board. Board Chair Schimel noted that the Board could make a decision at its next meeting (June 20).

ITEM 5. DISCUSS POSSIBLE RFP OR RFI BY INVESTMENT ADVISORS TO MAKE BEST INVESTMENTS FOR BCPL FUNDS

Board Chair Schimel said the discussion could be delayed until after the Board meets in July to consider a proposed investment strategy that would be presented by BCPL staff and deans from the UW School of Business.

ITEM 6. DISCUSS INVESTMENT OPTIONS

Commissioner Adamczyk thought it was important for the Board to consider options beyond agency staff for managing the School Trust Lands and trust fund investments. He would like the Board to discuss those options at an upcoming meeting.

ITEM 7. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

None.

ITEM 8. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT (continued)

Executive Secretary Barry reported that staff is working on several Trust Land transactions; he would provide a written report the week of June 13.

ITEM 9. ADJOURN

MOTION: Board Chair Schimel moved to adjourn the meeting; Commissioner Adamczyk seconded the motion.
