ITEM 4. DISCUSS AND VOTE ON PROPOSED LAND BANK SALE - DOROTHY LAKE (S1603)

Board Chair Schimel reported that staff had resolved a title conflict with the property and were recommending that the property, which is surrounded by DNR lands, be sold to the DNR.

MOTION: Board Chair Schimel moved to approve the land bank sale; Commissioner La Follette seconded the motion.

DISCUSSION: Executive Secretary Barry reported that an updated appraisal on the property resulted in an increased per acre value.

VOTE: The motion passed 3-0.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands approves the sale of the Property to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources at the price of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) in accordance with Chapter 24 of the Wisconsin Statutes on such terms and conditions as the Executive Secretary determines to be reasonable and necessary. The Executive Secretary is authorized and directed to execute any documents reasonably necessary to complete such transaction.

ITEM 6. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

Executive Secretary Barry said the Oneida County economic development loan approved by the Board would, according to the Oneida County Economic Development Corporation, help to preserve 524 existing jobs and add 20 new jobs, with more jobs anticipated in the future. He stated that he would keep the Board informed about any additional information regarding the loan and the project as it may become available.
