DISCUSSION: Commissioner Adamczyk asked if, in the past, limits had been placed on how much a municipality could borrow. He noted that even though the city of Menasha's population was approximately 19,000, they seem to be a "large borrower." Executive Secretary Barry replied that the municipality has used the State Trust Fund Loan Program to refinance existing debt and has been aggressively paying it off. He noted that Moody's had upgraded their bond rating to baa2.

Deputy Secretary German added that in the past constraints were placed on the amount any one community could borrow on a single loan application based on the available Trust Funds.

VOTE: The motion passed 2-1. Commissioner La Follette and Board Chair Schimel voted aye; Commissioner Adamczyk voted no.
